FURRIES FOR KIDS: CUDDLY ANIMALS CARE FOR ORPHANS

To make friendship perceptible is the goal that Europe's first and unique cuddling zoo pursues. Our voluntary workers regularly visit orphan children in children's villages and homes in cuddly animal costumes to foster the children's mental health through laughter and vitality. This helps in dealing with traumatic experiences.

Laughter as a therapy

The emotional and physical absence of their parents often creates a fear of bonding with someone else and causes gaps which are hard to fill. They unlearn to trust. This oftentimes affects even the youngest.

There the visits of our cuddly animals take effect. Furries For Kids helps children to relearn to trust and creates friendships in a playful manner. Because they resemble their smaller relatives our big, cuddly animals are quickly accepted and trusted. Their affection comes without conditions. Every child gets the exact amount of attention and closeness that they need and want.

„It's wonderful to see children forget about their emotional pain in a natural way“, confirms Angela Hartl, former director of the children's village of Pötsching. For her, the visits offer joy and play while helping to cope with negative experiences.

About Furries For Kids

Furries For Kids was founded in 2013 in Vienna. Its primary goal was to make people forget the troubles and sad phases of their daily life. Today the cuddly animals of Europe's first and unique regularly look after five children's villages and homes with about 200 children. All 40 voluntary workers work committedly to gift joy to many more children in Austria and Germany.

FUNDING

The visits and appearances of our cuddly zoo are a gift to the children. All our staff works honorary for a good cause. However, our work creates cost. For example, for travelling, materials, costumes, repairs and staff training.
